Grade 11 & 12 French Immersion Courses

Opportunities for French Immersion Students

- **Diplome D'études de Langue Française - DELF**
 - International recognition of French language proficiency
- ALL GPPSD schools support DELF assessments (in both FSL and FI classes). There is a fall DELF Exam Session and a Spring DELF Exam Session
 - Grade 9 students complete the DELF B1
 - Grade 12 students complete DELF B2
- **FSL Course Challenge** - French Immersion Students may challenge FSL10/20/30 and receive up to 15 high school credits.
 - Must Complete Grade (French Immersion Program
 - Must Complete DELF B1
