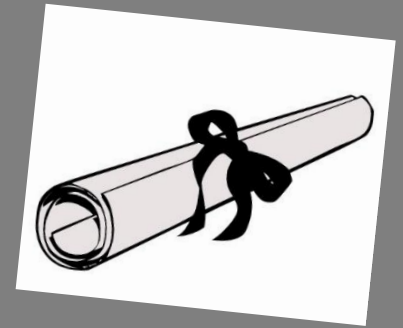

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- Total of **100 credits**, which must include the following:
 - **Grade 12 English** – ENG 30-1 or 30-2
 - **Grade 12 Social** – SS 30-1 or 30-2
 - **Grade 11 Math** – Math 20-1, 20-2 or 20-3
 - **Grade 11 Science** – Sc. 20, Sc. 24, BIO20, PHY20 or CHM20



GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- Total of **100 credits**, which must include the following:

- **Phys Ed** – 10 or 10T

- **Career & Life Management 20**

- **10 credits** in any combination from CTS, Fine Arts, Second Languages, PE 20 or 30 or RAP

- **10 Grade 12 credits OTHER than ENG & SS** – 30 level CTS, Math, Science, Fine Arts, Second Languages, PE, RAP or Work Experience



COURSE SELECTIONS

- Should have a minimum of 30 credits (approx. 6 courses) in your timetable, except for those who are registered in RAP
- Requirements for high school diploma vs post-secondary acceptance
- School's focus is helping every student attain a high school diploma

PRE-REQUISITES

- When selecting courses in Powerschool, you **MUST** make sure to have the necessary pre-requisites
- Ex: If you fail CHM20 and select CHM 30 for next year, you will not receive credits or marks for CHM 30
- Refer to the flow charts in the 2023-2024 course guide for clarification

MY PASS

- Need to register online with MyPass as soon as possible
- You can track your credits and diploma exam results
- myPass.alberta.ca
- You will need your ASN. Advisory teachers can help with this.

2. Review 2022 - 2023 Course Guide
3. Log into PowerSchool and follow instructions below
 1. Grade 9 - Fill in and return Option Selection forms distributed to Feeder Schools
 2. Grade 10 - Fill in selection forms distributed in health classes (also available at the office.)
 3. Grade 11-12 instructions (Current Grade 10 and 11 students)

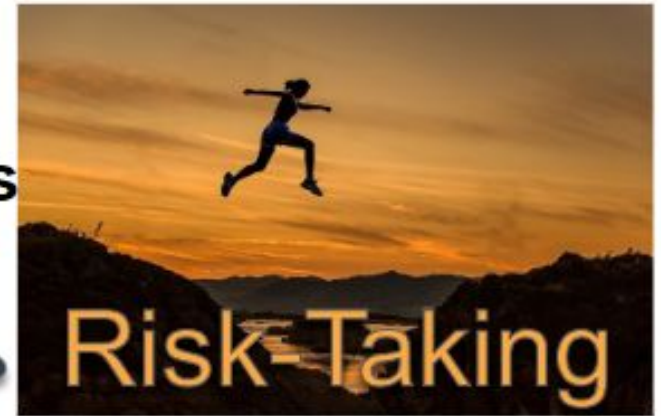

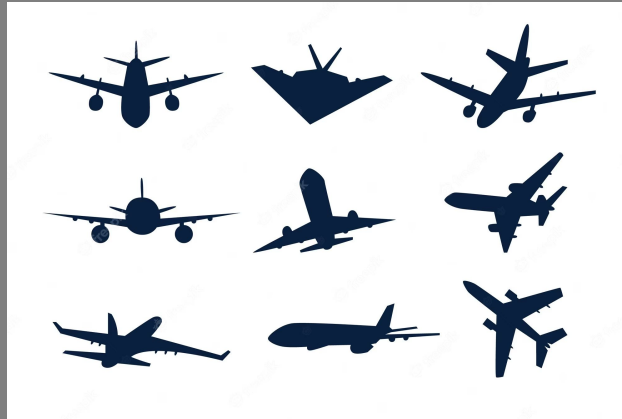

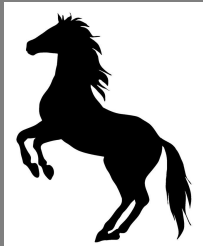
