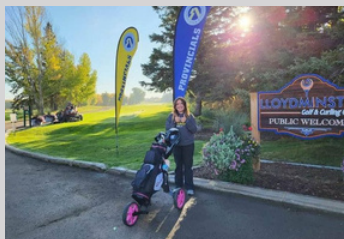


A Message from Our Principal

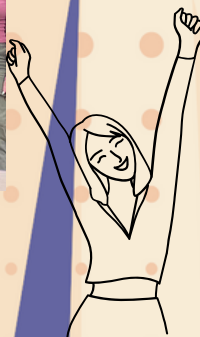

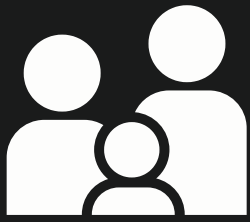
DANI GILLIS - INDIGENOUS LIASON

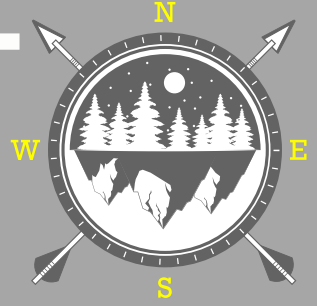

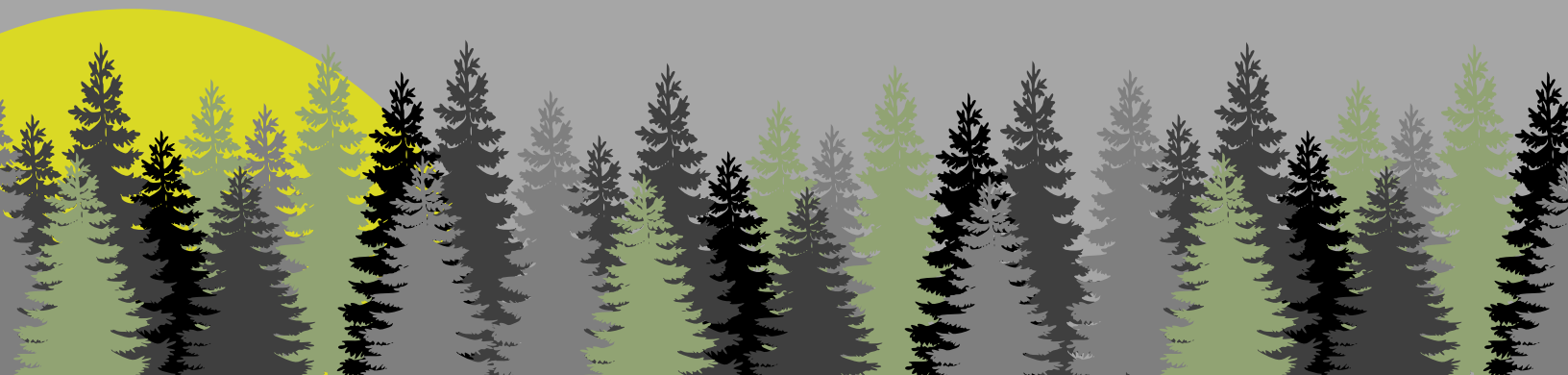

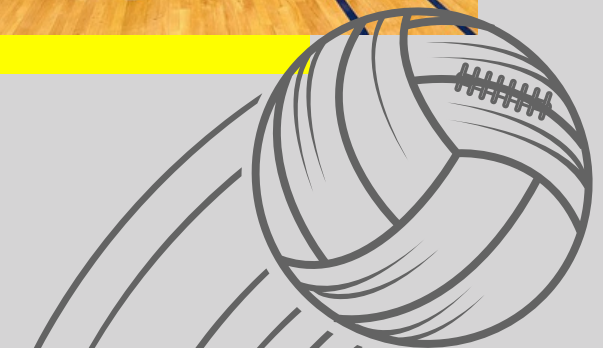
What a great first weekend for our Junior Varsity Volleyball Teams. The teams worked hard, battled together, learned a bunch and most importantly had a ton of fun.
