PowerSchool App - Best tool for Day-to-Day Use

Most parents find the PowerSchool App to be the most convenient way to track student attendance and to keep up to date with marks and feedback on assignments. However, the PowerSchool App is developed by a third party, so not all the functions in the web browser are available through the App. If you need support downloading the PowerSchool App see page 3. Report Cards

<u>The PowerSchool</u> website is still necessary to download a digital copy of a student's Semester 1 Report Card (see detailed instructions on page 2). Paper copies of our report cards are also available by request. Simply <u>contact us</u> through our website and request a paper copy in the message field. Please confirm your current address and our office will print and mail a physical copy of the report card to you.

At the beginning of every school year parents will be directly to complete digital forms through PowerSchool (School Engage).
