








#### GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

  - **Grade 12 Social** SS 30-1 or 30-2
  - **Grade 11 Math** Math 20-1, 20-2 or 20-3




• Grade 11 Science – Sc. 20, Sc. 24, BIO20, PHY20 or CHM20



#### GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- Total of **100 credits**, which must include the following:
  - **Phys Ed** 10 or 10T
  - Career & Life Management 20



- 10 credits in any combination from CTS, Fine Arts, Second Languages, PE 20 or 30 or RAP
- 10 Grade 12 credits OTHER than ENG & SS 30 level CTS, Math, Science, Fine Arts, Second Languages, PE, RAP or Work Experience

#### **APOP+ - Alberta Postsecondary Options Project**

Who: All Grade 12s will participate

Why: Remove barriers for post-secondary school

APOP involves attending three workshops held during school time. Two sessions will be in fall 2024, and one session will be in spring 2025.

- In the first workshop, students have the opportunity to explore postsecondary programs based on their interests, courses, and grades.
- In the second workshop, students apply for at least one of their chosen postsecondary programs with one application fee to a public Alberta institution paid by APOP.
- In the third workshop, students develop a budget and learn about the financial aid (i.e., grants, scholarships, bursaries, and/or loans) options available to them.



### MyPass

Student account that gives access to Alberta Education records including transcript requests and diploma exam marks.

- 1. Students need to supply us (Student Services) with a permanent e mail.
- 2. Create an account at this link.

#### Commencement Eligibility

- Students may be removed from the Commencement List at any time if there are attendance and/or academic concerns.
- Students have attended CSHS for the majority of their grade 12 year or be attending CSHS at the time of Commencement in order to participate in Commencement.
- Students will be notified of their placement on the Commencement List by letter delivered by their Block 1 teacher or to be picked up in the main office.


#### Parent Led Grad Celebrations
